Column B Preliminary CTE Credential w/ Industry Certificate or w/ 15 semester units or Clear CTE Credential

Column C Clear CTE Credential w/ Industry Certificate or w/ 15 semester units

Column D Clear CTE Credential w/ Industry Certificate w/ 15 semester units or Clear CTE Credential w/ 30 semester units

Column E Clear CTE Credential w/ Industry Certificate w/ 30 semester units or Clear CTE Credential w/ 45 semester units

Column F Clear CTE Credential w/ Industry Certificate w/ 45 semester units or Clear CTE Credential w/ 60 semester units

In order to receive salary schedule placement for an Industry Certificate, a minimum of 15 semester units or 22.5 quarter units must have been completed in order to earn the Certificate. In the event the Industry Certificate was not earned through a College or University, a minimum of 225.0 course hours will be considered equivalent to 15 semester units or 22.5 quarter units. Units or Industry Certificate hours will be recognized for salary schedule progression only if taken after the Preliminary Credential has been earned.

## Placement on Schedule:

Employees new to the District shall be granted salary schedule credit for up to ten (10) years of previous experience with a maximum salary schedule entry placement of step eleven (11), provided that such service shall meet all of the criteria established in the Certificated Master Contract.

Each teacher will be placed in the column for which he/she qualifies.

Units applied for any change in column placement for 2022-23 shall be completed prior to the start of the school year and be verified in the District Office with the transcript of documented grade records received prior to November 1st.

The District will apply the yearly % increases for all monetary benefits for certificated personnel (i.e., stipends, hourly rates, etc.).
